Organization Overview

Established in 1905, Minnehaha Country Club (MCC) is one of the Midwest's premier private clubs, providing an unmatched club experience within a nearly 200-mile geographic radius of Sioux Falls, South Dakota. Today's MCC is enjoying a period of growth and prosperity, with a waiting list for a golfing membership in excess of seven years. The 40,000 square-foot clubhouse recently underwent a \$9-million-dollar renovation, significantly enhancing the facility, and elevating the formal dining and event amenities. The Club is currently planning a full renovation of its casual restaurant amenities, which is scheduled for early 2023.

The Club boasts two restaurants, complete with clubhouse and patio dining, and accompanying lounges for both formal and casual dining experiences. Of these, Windows Restaurant provides members the premier, elevated dining experience in Sioux Falls and the region, complete with an active wine program, wine locker amenities, and a retail wine license. Additional F&B amenities include seasonal outdoor pool dining and the newly renovated banquet facilities that can accommodate approximately 250 seated guests. MCC has a very active membership which currently includes many young families, and provides a full slate of year-round social and dining events.

Minnehaha Country Club's championship 18-hole golf course was designed by William Langford and Theodore Moreau in 1922, and is consistently ranked among the best in the state. MCC proudly provides the finest golf experience in the region, and since 2018 has hosted the PGA Tour Champions event, *The Sanford International*. Additional sports amenities include a full driving range and short-game practice facilities, a newly renovated indoor golf simulator and fitness center, and clay tennis courts.

The City of Sioux Falls is booming at present and is among the fastest-growing communities in the nation. Sioux Falls provides excellent opportunities to raise a family surrounded by a community of Midwestern values, affordable housing, no state income tax, and a cost of living 6% below the national average. In fact, **Livability.com** recently named Sioux Falls the #5 best place to live in America.

MCC is managed by experienced General Manager/Chief Operating Officer Bret Coad, CCM, CCE, and a collaborative team of club professionals. Bret is a proven leader, committed to developing the careers of future club managers/leaders with a focus on work/life balance, and is active within the Club Management Association of America. The Club is governed by a small, five-person Board of Directors, and very few advisory committees, which has contributed to a very healthy and supportive environment for Club management and staff to manage operations effectively. Minnehaha Country Club membership includes many of Sioux Falls' business leaders and visionaries, and maintains a genuine midwestern sense of community and family.

The Food and Beverage Director supervises the Executive Chef, Windows Restaurant Manager, Players Grill Restaurant Manager, Catering & Events Sales Manager, and Pool Cabana Manager.

- Oversee multiple Food and Beverage outlets.
- Oversee the Beverage Program and procurement of beverage inventory, including wine, spirits, and beer.
- Oversee catering operation for events in excess of 200 guests.
- Develop ongoing training/professional development for the Food and Beverage team.
- Individual must be able to develop and manage a budget and operate the departments to meet the financial expectations, making adjustments as needed.
- Working in conjunction with the Executive Chef, develop appealing and varied menus and offerings.
